Regional Mass and Outreach in Hull for Unborn Children

A regional Mass to commemorate over ten million lives lost through abortion since the passing of the UK Abortion Act will be held at 10:30 am on Saturday 27th April 2024 at Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Peter Chanel Catholic church, Cottingham Road, Hull. The Mass will also be offered for all lives lost in the womb through natural miscarriage, and for all mothers, fathers, siblings and relatives who have lost children before birth. For those seeking further involvement in raising awareness through practical outreach, or simply wanting to perform an act of commemoration, a pro-life chain and silent witness is planned along Cottingham Road after the Mass from 12 noon to 1.00pm.

Attempts are currently being made in Parliament, spearheaded by Hull North MP Dame Diana Johnson, to liberalise abortion for any reason up to birth and this event is an opportunity for the community of Hull and East Riding to come together, celebrate a Mass of hope, demonstrate our love for life and send a message to the wider community and our lawmakers that abortion is not an acceptable sacrifice for societal failings. There will be refreshments after Mass and an opportunity to discover more about the political climate, the work of pro-life organisations and what you can do to improve the prospects for the most vulnerable in our society today.
