

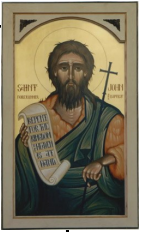

Adoremus next Saturday there will be a National Eucharistic Day at Oscott (the Birmingham Diocesan Seminary), parishes are asked to have a time of adoration after the main Mass that weekend.

So next **Sunday (15th) after the 10.30 Mass** there will be an hours Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. You may not be able to stay for a all of that time, but maybe plan on staying on, if only for 5 or 10 minutes.

Education Sunday this weekend we are asked to give thanks for and pray for the work of our Catholic Schools.

Mass on Tuesday will be the first Mass of the new school year when we will be joined by the children and staff of our school.

Mass Intentions.

Requesting that a Mass be offered for a particular intention can be one of the most generous of acts, for someone who has died, for someone who is sick or who is giving thanks.

Masses marked with my initials (DS) have come from outside the parish, so they can usually be moved.
